ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Completed registration form and entry fee must be received by JUNE 30, 2017.

All work, whether wall-hung or 3-dimensional, must be safe, ready to display, framed and wired appropriately for a gallery installation. Sawtooth hangers and tabletop photoframes with center hangers are not allowed. All work must be clearly labeled on the back/bottom of the artwork using the tags provided. Watercolors, prints, drawings and pastels must be framed under glass or plexiglas. All artwork must be original, made within the last 2 years and cannot have been previously exhibited at the Jamestown Arts Center. The Arts Center staff reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet these eligibility requirements and the artwork will not be displayed.

Due to space and technological limitations, please contact sjeppson@jamestownarts.com if you wish to submit large-scale work (over 36" in any direction), heavy work (30 lbs) or multimedia work.

Entry in the exhibition grants permission to photograph art for promotional or educational purposes.

BECOME A MEMBER ARTIST

In addition to a discounted membership to The Arts Center, you will be saving \$10 on each entry to the annual show, and you will receive invitations to events, and discounts on class registration fees. Owen is defined by a unique mix of experiences and skills, and is deeply engaged in the public discourse of designs' impact on culture. He served for five years on the Architecture+Design Museum, Lo s Angeles, Board of Directors, and continues to sit on the Museum Advisory Board. Deeply committed to reframing the use of materials and moving towards Zero Waste. Owen holds an Executive Masters of Business Administration (EMBA) from the University of Oregon, studied for his Masters of Architecture (MARCH) at the University of Hawaii and earned his BFA in Sculpture and Interior Architecture from the University of Massachusetts.

NEED HELP WITH DELIVERY?

A trip to retrieve/return art will be arranged to both Fargo and to Bismarck. There will be a single location selected as a drop off point in each town. Please email sjeppson@jamestownarts.com to sign up for this service.

END OF SHOW PICK UP OF ARTWORK

Hand-delivered artwork can be picked up starting Monday, October 9, 10 am – 5 pm. Storage is an issue, so prompt pickup is strongly encouraged. Shipped art work with return labels and return postage will be return shipped by October 16. Artwork not picked up by December 1, 2017 will become the property of The Arts Center.

SALES AND INSURANCE

A 30% commission will be charged on all works sold. Jamestown Fine Arts Association assumes responsibility for artwork while on display at the gallery; however, loss, damage, or deterioration of work during shipping is the responsibility of the artist.

PRIZES

Prizes will only be given in categories if there is a sufficient number of entries within that category. For example, if there is only one artist who has entered photographs in the show, they will not receive a prize within the photography category, however, these pieces will be considered for the Best of Show award.
