JUROR FOR PRIZES - GREG VETTEL

Greg Vettel classifies himself as a son (1982), husband (2008), father (2006, 2009, 2015), graphic designer (2006), teacher (2016), director (2018), nerd (forever), and student (always). He is also fond of lists. Vettel was immersed in art from a young age, a benefit of being in a family heavily involved in the Arts in North Dakota.

Vettel serves as the Director of the Northwest Arts Center and as an Adjunct Professor of Art at Minot State

University. With 12 years professional experience in creative and production graphic design, he employs his background in visual communication, multi-media, and technology as the digital tools instructor and technology coordinator for the Art Department, and, starting in 2018, as the Director of the Northwest Arts Center. At the Arts Center, Vettel is responsible for the management of the Walter Piehl Gallery and Minot State University's Permanent Art and Native American Collections.

As an artist, Vettel's work draws upon influences from technology, science (fiction and non) and pop culture; exploring through narrative forms how our increasingly digital world, for good or ill, is affecting individuals and societies, often inequitably. With interest in both digital and analog processes, he combines imagery and typography in printmaking, sculpture and digital mediums. Recently, he has been working with Flat Tail Press, Minot State University's educational print studio, on developing a letterpress studio for incorporation into FTP activities and curriculum within the Art Department at Minot State.

Vettel lives in Minot, North Dakota, with his wife, Jayme, and three children, Logan, Eva, and Jackson along with multiple four-legged friends.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

We request that artists complete the registration form by July 1, 2021. This gives us an important gauge of expected participation. We will always consider requests for entry beyond this deadline.

All work, whether wall-hung or 3-dimensional, must be safe, ready to display, framed and wired appropriately for a gallery installation. **Sawtooth hangers and tabletop photo-frames with center hangers are not allowed**. All work must be clearly labeled on the back/bottom of the artwork using the tags provided. Watercolors, prints, drawings and pastels must be framed under glass or Plexiglas. All artwork must be original, preferably made within the last 2 years and cannot have been previously exhibited at the Jamestown Arts Center. The Arts Center staff reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet these eligibility requirements and the artwork will not be displayed.

END OF SHOW PICK UP OF ARTWORK

Hand-delivered artwork can be picked up starting Monday, October 12, 10 am – 5 pm. Storage is an issue, so prompt pickup is strongly encouraged. Shipped art work with return labels and return postage will be return shipped by October 20.

SALES AND INSURANCE

A 30% commission will be charged on all works sold. Jamestown Fine Arts Association assumes responsibility for artwork while on display at the gallery; however, loss, damage, or deterioration of work during shipping is the responsibility of the artist.

PRIZES

Prizes will only be given in categories if there is a sufficient number of entries within that category. For example, if there is only one artist who has entered photographs in the show, they will not receive a prize within the photography category, however, these pieces will be considered for the Best of Show award.

Entry in the exhibition grants permission to photograph art for promotional or educational purposes.
