JUROR FOR PRIZES - PAUL NOOT

Paul Noot received his BFA from the University of North Dakota and his MFA from Brooklyn College in New York. Noot grew up in the Valley City/Marion area of North Dakota. Paul has worked with the Metropolitan Museum of Art in NYC, and North Dakota Museum of Art in Grand Forks and is currently the head of the Visual Arts department at Bismarck High School. He also teaches classes for Sleepy Hollow Summer Arts, International Music Camp, BDAC and Continuing Education courses

for the University of North Dakota. Noot is a founding member of the Bismarck Downtown Artist Cooperative.

Paul has exhibited in the region and is the recipient of several art awards. In 2002 he was awarded the Citation Award from Bismarck Art & Galleries Association, in 2004 the KXMB Spirit Award, and 2005-06 the Golden Apple Award, and in 2009 the BAGA Volunteer Award. He was a winner in the Millennium Art Trail Project in 2002, and the Lewis & Clark Banner contest in 2003. Paul has been in several regional art exhibits and his work is in public and private collections. Recent commissioned work can be seen at the Pirogue Grille, Bismarck, and a two hundred foot mural in Valley City. He also painted a horse for Easter Seals of North Dakota, a mini-bus for American Cancer Society of North Dakota, and a child statue for Manchester House of Bismarck. Paul has a connection to Jamestown as he created two mosaic benches for the Hansen Arts Park and created a mosaic "free little library" for Bismarck High School. In 2017, Noot was awarded the ND Governor's Arts Award for Art Education. He has taught at Sleepy Hollow, International Music Camp and currently teaches class for Bismarck Downtown Artist Cooperative.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Completed registration form and entry fee must be received by JULY 15, 2019.

All work, whether wall-hung or 3-dimensional, must be safe, ready to display, framed and wired appropriately for a gallery installation. **Sawtooth hangers and tabletop photo-frames with center hangers are not allowed**. All work must be clearly labeled on the back/bottom of the artwork using the tags provided. Watercolors, prints, drawings and pastels must be framed under glass or Plexiglas. All artwork must be original, made within the last 2 years and cannot have been previously exhibited at the Jamestown Arts Center. The Arts Center staff reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet these eligibility requirements and the artwork will not be displayed.

END OF SHOW PICK UP OF ARTWORK

Hand-delivered artwork can be picked up starting Monday, September 23, 10 am – 5 pm. Storage is an issue, so prompt pickup is strongly encouraged. Shipped art work with return labels and return postage will be return shipped by October 1.

SALES AND INSURANCE

A 30% commission will be charged on all works sold. Jamestown Fine Arts Association assumes responsibility for artwork while on display at the gallery; however, loss, damage, or deterioration of work during shipping is the responsibility of the artist.

PRIZES

Prizes will only be given in categories if there is a sufficient number of entries within that category. For example, if there is only one artist who has entered photographs in the show, they will not receive a prize within the photography category, however, these pieces will be considered for the Best of Show award.

Entry in the exhibition grants permission to photograph art for promotional or educational purposes.
