JUROR FOR PRIZES - MARK STRAND

Mark Strand is a photographer, graphic designer and art collector living in Fargo. He retired from teaching in the mass communications department at Minnesota State University Moorhead in 2014. Strand grew up in a family-owned photography business in Rugby, ND. and graduated from Concordia College, Moorhead where the president told his parents, "He's a little liberal, but he'll be all right." He did his graduate work at the Creative Photography Laboratory, Department of Architecture,

Massachusetts Institute of Technology. The program is now known at the M.I.T. Media Lab.

Strand served as President of the Rourke Art Gallery Museum, 1986-96. He has juried art exhibitions in the past and won several awards for his work. From 2011-2018 he photographed Jamestown and the surrounding landscape. The result was an exhibition at The Arts Center in 2016 and a book in 2018. Strand says he will always be grateful to his longtime Jamestown friend Bruce Berg for introducing him to the city's West End and McGinnis Cemetery. His latest publication is a book of photos with text about the artist Frank Sampson and the exhibition originating at the North Dakota Museum of Art shown here this June and July. As part of his research on collaborative projects by the artist Cyrus Running and architect Edward Sövik, Strand has organized an effort to clean and restore a 9x54 ft. mural that Running created for a library designed by Sövik. The mural is now part of the permanent collection of Rourke Art Gallery Museum in Moorhead.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Completed registration form should be received by July 15, 2020. Late entries will be accepted please call or email sjpeppson@jamestownarts.com if you miss the deadline.

All work, whether wall-hung or 3-dimensional, must be safe, ready to display, framed and wired appropriately for a gallery installation. **Sawtooth hangers and tabletop photo-frames with center hangers are not allowed.** All work must be clearly labeled on the back/bottom of the artwork using the tags provided. Watercolors, prints, drawings and pastels must be framed under glass or Plexiglas. All artwork must be original, made within the last 2 years and cannot have been previously exhibited at the Jamestown Arts Center. The Arts Center staff reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet these eligibility requirements and the artwork will not be displayed.

SHIPPING AND DELIVERY

END OF SHOW PICK UP OF ARTWORK

Hand-delivered artwork can be picked up starting Monday, October 12, 10 am – 5 pm. Storage is an issue, so prompt pickup is strongly encouraged. Shipped art work with return labels and return postage will be return shipped by October 19.

SALES AND INSURANCE

A 30% commission will be charged on all works sold. Jamestown Fine Arts Association assumes responsibility for artwork while on display at the gallery; however, loss, damage, or deterioration of work during shipping is the responsibility of the artist.

PRIZES

Prizes will only be given in categories if there is a sufficient number of entries within that category. For example, if there is only one artist who has entered photographs in the show, they will not receive a prize within the photography category, however, these pieces will be considered for the Best of Show award.

Entry in the exhibition grants permission to photograph art for promotional or educational purposes.
